
1) The applicants may, in accordance with paragraphs (a), (c) and (f) of Rule 1:13-9, file a motion to appear as amicus and a proposed amicus brief no later than 11:00 a.m. on June 11, 2013;

2) An original and one copy of the motion and proposed brief shall be served and filed with the clerk of this court and a copy of each shall be delivered to the respective chambers of Judges Grall, Koblitz, Accurso;

3) The court will provide Judge Accurso with a copy of papers submitted prior to this order;

4) In the event either party wishes to oppose one or both motions to appear as amicus, opposition must be served and filed no later than 11:00 a.m. on June 12, 2013, filing to be done in the manner specified in paragraph two of this order.
